Cost to Host: \$100 (plus cost to provide lunch) | Free to Attend

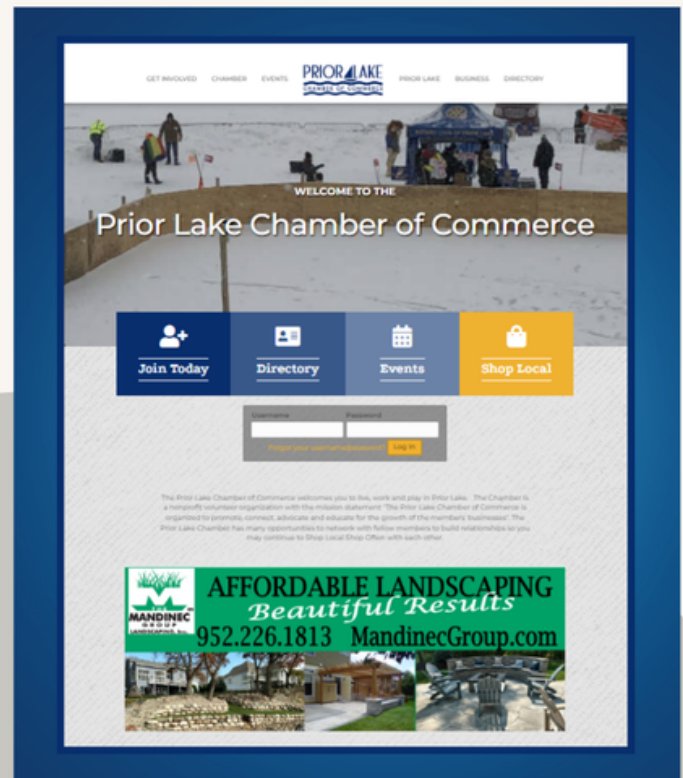
